

CESAR MILSTEIN AWARD 2018 – Society of Clinical Investigation (SAIC), Society of Immunology (SAI) and Society of Physiology (SAFIS) Meeting 2018

This Award is a Novartis initiative to support and enhance local translational science capabilities. The Award consists of 1-3 months internship at Novartis Institutes of Biomedical Research (NIBR).

Guided by Novartis mentors, the interns will work on a jointly-agreed upon, precompetitive scientific or clinical research project. Research projects expose selected scientist to state-of-the-art methodologies and leading experts in the fields while ensuring use within their home infrastructure.

Guidelines for the Applicants 2018 - Submission deadline: August 15th, 2018

Award benefits

- working on a research project of interest to their local scientific and clinical communities
- augmenting their scientific capabilities through seminars, journal club, discussion forums, and various educational courses
- networking and collaborating within the intern group, with their mentors, the greater Novartis scientific community, and where possible, with other academic collaborators
- supporting their educational goals and scientific career development through mentorship

The Award includes

- Scientific/Clinical Research Infrastructure and Training: All necessary equipment, training and operational needs (e.g. computers, supplies and reagents) will be provided by Novartis to support investigation of a jointly agreed-upon, pre-competitive (non-proprietary) scientific question or challenge.
- Travel, Accommodations & Visas: Novartis will provide (a) round-trip economy class airfare, (b) student accommodation for the duration of the project, and (c) application for educational visas to the Swiss authorities on behalf of the selected participants.
- Stipend and Health Insurance: Novartis will provide health insurance and a monthly stipend to cover incidentals and basic living expenses.
- Timelines & Location: The internship will be for 1-3 months depending on the project agreed. It

will take place in any Novartis NIBR laboratory (i.e. Basel, Switzerland; Cambridge, USA; New Jersey, USA)

Selection Process

Only one postulant will get the Award.

Submitted abstracts have to be original on the topic:

After a pre-selection of four postulants out of all the applications received, a jury will make a final decision based on a 15 min oral presentation of the candidates with 5 min questions in an especial session during the SAIC SAI SAFIS 2018 Congress.

The applicant has to be a graduated in biomedical sciences and up to 35 years old. People integrating SAIC governing/administrative bodies in any working relation with the Society will be inhibited from participation. This statement also applies to the governing/administrative bodies in any working relation with the other Societies organizing the Joint Meeting: the SAI (Argentine Society of Immunology), the SAFIS (Argentine Society of Physiology), the Nanomed-ar (Argentine Association of Nanomedicines) and the SAV (Argentine Society of Virology).

The jury, both for the pre-selection and the final decision, will be integrated by Novartis and SAIC members in equal proportion.

The pre-selection process might include a short 10 min presentation to the jury in Buenos Aires in the week previous to the SAIC SAI SAFIS Meeting.
